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IMPORTANT! READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

Read all instructions before assembling and using the all- purpose carrier.

## WARNING FALL AND SUFFOCATION HAZARD

WARNING: This carrier is not for use while swimming. The carrier may be used while standing or walking in waist deep water only, don't wade into water too deep to maintain firm footing.

- Prior to each use, check for ripped seams, damaged fasteners, or torn straps.
- Ensure proper placement of child in product including leg placement. Child must face towards you until they can hold head upright.

- Hot tubs, spas, and pools heated to more than 100 degrees Fahrenheit are off limits to children younger than 3 years of age.
- Water temperature should not be lower than 85 degrees Fahrenheit to maintain baby's comfort. If your child starts shivering, it is time to get out.

## WARNING FALL AND SUFFOCATION HAZARD

## FALL HAZARD-INFANTS CAN FALL THROUGH A WIDE LEG OPENING OR OUT OF CARRIER

- Adjust leg openings to fit baby's legs snugly.
- Before each use, make sure all buckles and straps are secure.
- Take special care when leaning or walking.
- Never bend at waist; bend at knees.
- Only use this carrier for children between
   7 LBS 45 LBS.

## WARNING FALL AND SUFFOCATION HAZARD

SUFFOCATION HAZARD-INFANTS UNDER 4 MONTHS CAN SUFFOCATE IN THIS PRODUCT IF FACE IS PRESSED TIGHT AGAINST YOUR BODY.

- Do not strap baby too tight against your body.
- Allow room for head movement.
- Keep infant's face free from obstructions at all times.

#### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE ASSEMBLING FOR USF. NEVER LEAVE BABY UNATTENDED IN OR WITH THE AMPHIBA BABY INFANT TO TODDLER CARRIER. NEVER USE A SOFT STRUCTURED INFANT CARRIER WHEN BAI ANCE OR MOBILITY IS IMPAIRED BECAUSE OF EXERCISE. DROWSINESS OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS. NEVER WEAR A SOFT STRUCTURED INFANT CARRIER WHEN DRIVING OR BEING A PASSENGER IN A VEHICLE, BE CARFFUL WHEN FATING OR DRINKING HOT BEVERAGES WHEN WEARING A BABY IN A CARRIER, NEVER USE A SOFT CARRIER WHILE FNGAGING IN ACTIVITIES SUCH AS COOKING AND CLEANING WHICH INVOLVE A HEAT SOURCE OR EXPOSURE TO CHEMICALS, BE AWARE THAT AS BABY BECOMES MORE ACTIVE. THEY ARE AT RISK OF MOVING AROUND MORE AND FALLING OUT OF THE CARRIER. THERE SHOULD BE AT LEAST TWO FINGERS WIDT H CLEARANCE BEFORE BABY'S CHIN.

#### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE:

MAKE SURE BABY CAN BREATHE NORMALLY AT ALL TIMES. THE CARRIER SHOULD BE POSITIONED SO THAT BABY CAN MOVE THEIR HEAD WITHOUT TOUCHING THE CAREGIVER'S CHEST.

INFANTS, INFANTS WITH RESPIRATORY
PROBLEMS, AND INFANTS UNDER FOUR MONTHS
OF AGE ARE AT GREATEST RISK OF
SUFFOCATION. ENSURE PROPER PLACEMENT OF
BABY IN PRODUCT AT ALL TIMES. CHECK
BABY'S POSITION REGULARLY TO MAKE SURE
THE BABY IS SEATED IN THE CENTER OF THE
CARRIER WITH LEGS IN THE "M" POSITION OR
SPREAD-SQUAT POSITION. WHEN USING THE
HOOD, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THE HOOD IS
NOT COMPLETELY COVERING BABY'S FACE AND
BABY CAN MOVE THEIR HEAD NORMALLY.

#### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE:

BE SURE THERE IS ENOUGH OPENING FOR AIR TO PASS THROUGH. ALWAYS FASTEN THE BUCKLES PROPERLY WHEN THE CARRIER IS NOT IN USE. CHECK TO ENSURE THAT ALL BUCKLES, SNAPS, STRAPS, AND ADJUSTMENTS ARE SECURE BEFORE EACH USE. REGULARLY INSPECT THE CARRIER FOR ANY SIGN OF WEAR AND TEAR OR DAMAGE.

THE AMPHIBA BABY INFANT TO TODDLER CARRIER IS NOT DESIGNED TO CARRY A CHILD IN THE OUTWARD FACING POSITION. ONLY USE THE BACK CARRY WHEN INFANT HAS DEMONSTRATED STRONG HEAD AND NECK CONTROL. TAKE THE BABY OUT OF THE CARRIER BEFORE CHANGING POSITION OF THE CARRIER. WHEN CHANGING POSITION OF THE CARRIER TO BACK CARRY, DO SO OVER A BED OR SOFT CUSHIONED SURFACE WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF ANOTHER ADULT.





#### FRONT CARRY INSTRUCTIONS

Infant is worn on the caregiver's chest facing inwards.

Min. 7lbs / 32kg to Max. 45lbs

Step One: Position the waistband with the warning label facing towards you. Snap

the buckle.



Step Two: To tighten the waistband, pull the 2" webbing to fit comfortably around your waist. It should fit snugly and with no gaps.



Step Three: Hold your baby facing towards you, chest to chest. Their legs should be in the 'M' position, bent at the knee.




Step Four: Slide one arm through the arm strap, continue to support baby with the other arm.



Step Four (cont'd): Slide your other arm through the arm strap, continue to support the baby with your free arm.



Step Five: Reach behind your back and buckle the chest strap. Pull on the 1" webbing to tighten the chest strap.




#### **BACK CARRY INSTRUCTIONS**


Infant is worn on the caregiver's back facing in. This position is meant for infants that have head and neck control.

Step One: Position the warning label facing in. The carrier should be positioned in the center of your back. Snap the buckle and tighten the waist band to your comfort level, making sure there are no gaps.

Step Two: Put the baby on your hip.



Step Three: Lean forward over a couch or other soft structure and slide the baby towards the center of your back. Keep the baby supported with your hands and arms the entire time.




Step Four: Put the first shoulder strap on while continuing to support the baby with your other arm.



Step Five: Put the second shoulder strap on and buckle the chest strap. Tighten the chest strap to your comfort level, making sure the infant is secure.



Step Five (cont'd): Ensure that the infant is seated in the center of the panel, stand straight up and pull on the webbing of the shoulder straps and chest strap to tighten.




#### HOW TO ADJUST THE CARRIER:

#### **CORRECT POSITIONING:**


The panel width can be determined based on each baby's individual comfort and leg-span. The baby should be seated with the base of the carrier spread from knee to knee, with their knees raised slightly above their bottom in the shape of an "M." The seat width should completely support your baby in that positioning, with the panel coming just to the crease of the baby's knees. Proper placement of the baby in the carrier, including leg placement, should always be ensured.

The narrowest setting can be used for newborns and small babies.

Min. 7lbs/32kg Fully cinched waist appropriate size for a newborn:



In this position the body of the carrier has been fully released. This is the appropriate size for a bigger baby or toddler:



#### **CARRIER HOOD FEATURES:**

- Extra large size.
- Offers coverage when nursing.
- Acts as head support for your infant when in the rolled-up position.
- Provides head support as your baby grows into a toddler.
- Includes six buttons to adjust size as needed.
- Can be rolled up and tucked away into hood holders.
- Hood holders serve as attachments for pacifiers, baby toys, keys, and more.

## 3 CARRIER HOOD POSITIONS TO SUPPORT BABY FROM INFANT TO TODDLER:

1. Fully released works best for infants 12 months and older.



2. Fully cinched works best for newborns up to 6 months old.



Partly Cinched works best for babies 6 months to 12 months old.



#### HOW TO ADJUST THE CARRIER HOOD:

<u>Step One:</u> Snap the center buttons together toward the midline of the hood.



<u>Step Two:</u> Snap the buttons on the outer edge down together.



Step Three: All done! The hood is now fully cinched.



#### WASH & CARE

Before washing fasten all buckles. Machine wash cold. Do not Iron. Do not bleach. Dry normal, low heat. Do Not Dry Clean. Do not use detergents with bleach, dyes, or optical brighteners.
